Were previously covered under the Plan and are on an approved leave of absence from your academic program.

IS and IP Only student. Those students who are working on "In Progress" courses, and who are not registered for any other units, will be charged the enrollment fee.

Additional information regarding eligibility:

Students who drop before the deadline will not be charged nor covered. Any student who is charged the fee and drops all units before the last day for a full refund (generally 1 week after the first day of classes), will receive a full refund of the enrollment fee and they will have no access to any University benefits. Please refer to the Student Finance 100% refund policy.

LLUH employees who are "full time benefit eligible" will not be charged the fee. The fee will not apply regardless of whether employees are using the education benefit or not. Spouses of employees who are using the employee education benefit will be charged the enrollment fee.

An eligible student's coverage will become effective on the first day of class or student orientation, whichever occurs first

BUY-IN PROVISION

Under the following provisions a student may obtain coverage under this health plan or extend coverage to a spouse or dependent children each quarter. In order to receive any coverage under this Plan, a student must apply for coverage during an open enrollment period, within 30

The open enrollment period for eligible students and dependents is the last two weeks of each calendar quarter. Buy-in coverage will be effective from January 1 to March 31, April 1 to June 30, July 1 to September 30 and October 1 to December 31. There are no invoices or reminders sent to students who are buying in to the Plan. The Department of Risk Management cannot add Student Health Plan fees to your student account. All payments

order option. This mail order option is only offered through the CVS Mail Order Pharmacy. Note that the normal co-payment is waived for generic medications that are filled through the mail-order program and are used for the treatment of asthma, cholesterol, diabetes, heart failure and hypertension.

Video Visits are covered under the Plan with Student Health Services. This service provides online access to physicians at the Student Health Services with no co-payment. Video Visits with

Basic Services including:

- clinic visit and exam
- necessary diagnostic x-rays and pathology
- restorations (fillings) amalgam, silicate cement, plastic and composite restorations
- endodontics root canals, pulp capping
- non-surgical tooth extractions

Limitations:

- bitewing and periapical x-rays are not covered during any year that the patient receives full mouth x-rays
- sealants will only be covered on un-restored bicuspids and first and second molars, every three years

Exclusions:

- dental crowns, cast restorations, inlays, onlays, implants, dentures or a fixed bridge
- diagnosis or treatment by any method of any condition related to the
